



During every shift I have I usually talk to 3 or 4 people, some of them are familiar faces that I often see around.

The people I talked to understood the importance of having a clean Dam and suggested some methods to make it cleaner and more organized.

Some quotes in that direction are: "I search through the bins and always return back what I don't need, but I see others just leave the trash they don't need out".

Someone else said, "I never make a mess and I always close the bins after I take what I need, as someone with a yellow jacket and long blond hair asked me to".

Another said: "These bins have been broken for months before I was here, I never break into the

bins"

From my observation In Amsterdam, it is necessary to facilitate the collection of Statigeld bottles by homeless individuals, especially the undocumented, as these recyclables are often a reliable source of income. This will reduce the number of bins that the homeless will go through and will save the trash bins from getting destroyed which can create a mess. Keeping close observation of the location helps create awareness among people who are going through the bins for their daily living.
