On Friday the 8th of November a press conference was held in which the mayor, together with the other members of the local authorities (police and the Public Prosecution office), provided an explanation - based on the information available at that moment - about the events that have taken place on the 7th of November, the preparations leading up to that day and the actions taken after.

As you might know, the mayor is elected by the city council of Amsterdam. Today at 12:00 local time, with the information available at the moment, she will provide an explanation and extensive accountability to the representatives in the city council about the events that occurred over the past days, which are also the subject of your email.
