I am reaching out to you, as I would like to express my concerns, and raise an objection to the plans of the Harvest Group regarding the building of Zaanstraat 1.

I live in one of the neighbouring apartments (ground floor with garden), and would be greatly impacted by the planned extra layer of houses on the top of the school, Zaanstraat 1.

The extra layer would have negative impact on the neighbours' (especially the direct neighbours') wellbeing. It would significantly reduce the amount of sunlight reaching my garden and my living room / kitchen area which is located in the part of my home facing the backyard. Less light would impact my garden's overall ambiance and make it less enjoyable, making it feels compressed. I am afraid that the backyard will be overshadowed. If the living room got less light in, it would take away from the quality of my living. The extra layer would also alter the view which would be compromised for us who are already living here.

I would like to express my concern about the "glass wall"-like extra layer as well. It would negatively affect my privacy. Besides, it would probably also cause light pollution towards the gardens in the backyard, which is not the case at the moment.

Due to the above mentioned, I would like to kindly ask you not to support the extension plan submitted for permission by the Harvest Group, and reject that.
